Regardless of Mr. Hudson's participation in the production a \$1,500 royalty shall be paid to him by opening night of the rental company's production. If engaged, round trip airfare, accommodations, and travel are the responsibility of the renters and are part of this agreement.

CeCe Sickler serves as the costume designer for this production. Her fee to re-costume the production shall be negotiated directly with her. Regardless of Ms. Sickler's participation in the production, a \$1,500 royalty shall be paid to her by opening night of the rental company's production. If engaged, round trip airfare, accommodations, and travel are the responsibility of the renters and are part of this agreement.

Peter Nolle & Doug Provost serve as the scenic designers for this production. Their fee to re-design the production shall be negotiated directly with them. Regardless of Mr. Nolle's or Mr. Provost's participation in the production a \$1,000 royalty shall be paid to each of them by opening night of the rental company's production. If engaged, round trip airfare, accommodations, and travel are the responsibility of the renters and are part of this agreement.

Transportation

Scenery, props and costumes come in (2) 53' straight floor Air-Ride Equipped trailer, equipped with 8 load bars, 16 ratchet straps and 40 packing blankets. Transportation is the sole responsibility of the renting company.
